## Update on the Asylum Seeking Family

There has been great progress over the last couple of weeks with Comlanvi and Zourfahou and their little boys: English Language Learning (ELL) is underway; they've taken first steps on the legal front; we've secured a twobedroom apartment at Lakeview Gardens here in Natick; we're working on enrolling the family for medical care; and a Steering Committee with representation from several of the member congregations of the coalition has met and will share leadership responsibilities going forward. Donations are still coming in, and we're within \$10,000 of our \$50,000 target for the first year.

So many of you have given generously of yourselves, in expertise, time, networking, monetary and in-kind contributions. Thank you!

This Sunday we welcome back to Christ Lutheran, Maria Hedberg who joins Anne Weaver in playing excerpts from Georg Phillip Telemann's "canonic" sonatas for the Prelude and Postlude music. Telemann (1681-1767) ingeniously designed this set of sonatas for two solo flutes or two solo violins so that one instrument follows the other exactly one measure later, playing the same melodic line. Handel is reported to have claimed that Telemann could compose a musical work with eight simultaneous melodic lines "as easily as anyone else could write a letter." Maria is Hilding Hedberg's niece. Their recordings were made in person at Christ Lutheran Church this past week.

Local author Jennifer DeLeon will join us via Zoom to discuss her Young Adult novel, *Don't Ask Me Where I'm From.* Goodreads' description: "First-generation American LatinX Liliana Cruz does what it takes to fit in at her new nearly all-white school. But when family secrets spill out and racism at school ramps up, she must decide what she believes in and take a stand." Set in the fictionalized community of "Westburg", the novel describes the experiences of Liliana who is half-Guatemalan, half-Salvadoran as she participates in METCO, the actual Boston program that buses students from the city to the affluent suburbs of the Metrowest.

The novel is a timely read in this current era of racial consciousness as we learn the complex effects of racism in our culture.

## Call to Action

Last weekend we picked up the keys for Comlanvi and Zourfahou's new apartment, and this week, we're expecting the management to repaint it. That means that we'll be ready to do some light cleaning on Friday, and begin moving the family in on Saturday, May 8th.

Here is what we hope to do, beginning at 11:00 on Friday, May 6th:

- Clean four windows, each approximately 42"x42" (all close to the ground and easy to reach)
- General cleaning and dusting of baseboard heating units and closets
- General dusting throughout
- Size, cut and place shelf paper in kitchen and linen closet.

Tape measurers, a ruler, scissor and step ladder for shelf paper work will be provided. Please bring your own cleaning supplies for other cleaning goals.
