For this Sunday, we'll be singing *Morning Has Broken*, *Come, Thou Fount of Every Blessing*, *There's a Wideness in God's Mercy*. 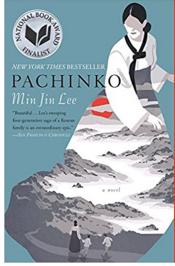
