APPLE BROWNIE DESSERT

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup shortening1 cup flour<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> teaspoon cinnamon

1 teaspoon soda <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup chopped nuts

1 cup white sugar

Cream shortening and sugar, add beaten egg, mix well. Add flour, soda, nutmeg, cinnamon, mix well and add chopped nuts and raw apples. Pour into greased  $9 \times 13$  pan and bake at 350 F for 35 - 40 minutes. Serve warm with the following sauce:

SAUCE:	$\frac{1}{2}$ cup $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ cream	½ cup white sugar
	½ cup brown sugar	<sup>1</sup> /4 cup butter

Cook slowly for 10 minutes, stirring constantly. Remove from heat and add 1 teaspoon vanilla. Serve warm over the apple dessert. ENJOY





2 cups peeled, chopped apples

1 beaten egg

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> teaspoon nutmeg
