

**Board of Trustees of Newark Presbytery  
Report to the Presbytery of Northern New Jersey  
March 11, 2021**

*The Board of Trustees of Newark Presbytery met on Feb. 23, 2021, and took the following actions:*

1) In response to a Feb. 16, 2021 communication from attorney Charles Z. Schal, **voted** to retain the law firm of Inglesino, Webster, Wyciskala & Taylor, LLC to represent the Newark Presbytery Board of Trustees in any legal matters related to the real property at 377 Clinton Avenue, Newark, NJ (former Central Presbyterian Church site) and any former members of the Central Presbyterian Church or any other persons holding membership in the Presbytery of Newark at this time. This motion shall remain in force in the new ecclesial Presbytery of Northeast New Jersey.

2) **Voted** to authorize Stated Clerk Warren McNeill to obtain property and liability insurance on the property at 377 Clinton Av, Newark, NJ.

*The Board of Trustees of Newark Presbytery met on March 11, 2021, and took the following actions:*

1) **Voted** to accept the 2019 Financial Review prepared by Michael Caro at Bederson as a full and accurate representation of the Presbytery of Newark's financial reporting and situation as of Dec. 31, 2019.

2) **Voted** to accept the recommendation of the Capital Assets Committee to give a \$5,000 Capital Grant to Bloomfield Presbyterian Church on the Green. (R. Boling and G. Maciag recused themselves from this discussion and the vote as this matter relates to their congregation.)
